Dear Parents and Carers,

Good afternoon, I hope you are all well and enjoying the extra bit of freedom that has been allowed following the relaxing of restrictions. The weather has been unsettled and that often can affect the way we feel and our ability to get out and about. With school opening its doors to more children on Monday (Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6) staff are mindful of the children who will remain at home. Thank you again for all the support you have given you children over the last few months, the work has been excellent and staff have all commented on the engagement of pupils and quality of work produced.




Luke's alarm clock inspired by the Greeks.
