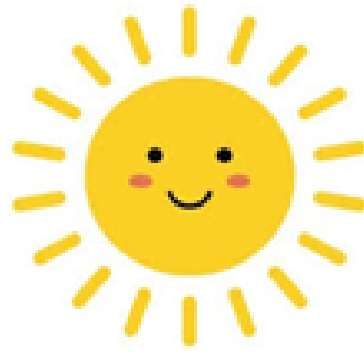


Please also make sure your children have sun cream and a sunhat with them as the summer months approach, so we can take our learning outside and enjoy the weather safely.
