Being at the heart of our community is so important to us in school and we are beyond delighted that so many people were able to spend an afternoon of Story, Song and Music with us.

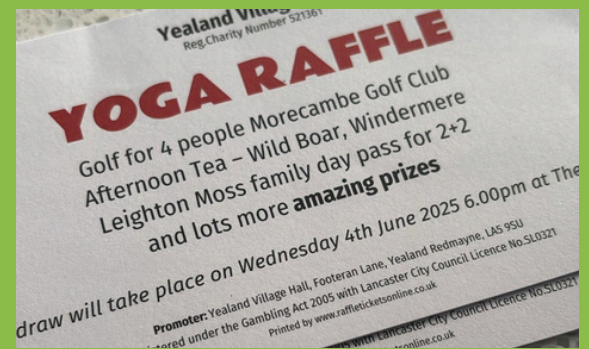
We are so proud of our children and it was lovely to share their many talents with so many.
