The answerphone will start recording messages from 5pm. If you need to speak to a member of staff after this time, please contact them through REMIND.

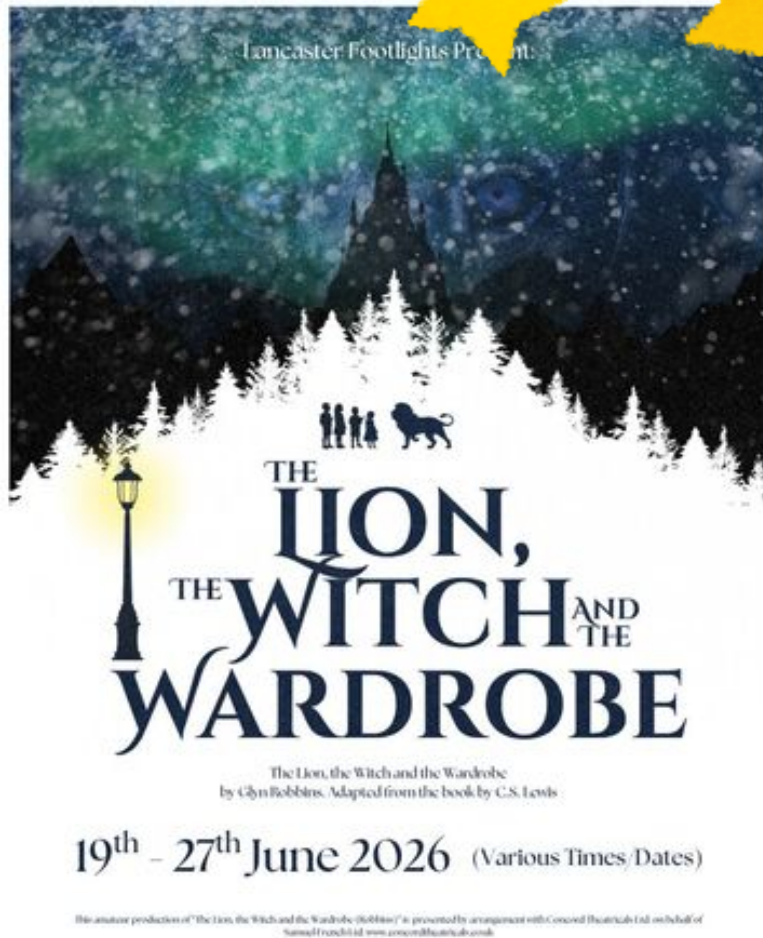
